Come and ride as many laps as you want. Net proceeds from the event will be donated to the NETRA Scholarship Fund.

The 38<sup>th</sup> Annual Cracker Barrel Fair will also be running from noon to 10 pm on the grounds of the Wrentham Development Center offering rides, vendors, food, etc. for additional entertainment after the ride.

Basic safety gear is required; helmet, goggles, boots, pants, long sleeve shirts & gloves

Netra membership is required, \$25 one day membership or various annual membership options (\$25 Junior, \$45 adult Individual or \$65 Family).

No camping, food available, sign up and tech inspection open at 8 am.

Minors must have a parent present or a notarized consent form.

This is a non-competitive fun ride, a great chance to ride with your entire family.
